On Saturday, November 1, 2008 from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM, residents and businesses are invited to drop off and recycle their printers, scanners, CPUs, computer monitors, laptops, internal computer components, telephones, telecommunication equipment, cameras, radios, modems, pagers, VCRs, DVD players, hand held games and other electronic equipment. The event will be held at LaCenterra at Cinco Ranch at 23501 Cinco Ranch Boulevard and the Grand Parkway in Katy, Texas. Televisions will not be accepted at this event. This event is open to the general public.

“The Arc of Katy currently has a membership of 65 which includes community members as well as families of individuals with disabilities. The Adult Day Activity Camp serves around 20 participants on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Other social activities include monthly dances and Bingo nights. All donations will be used for expanding programs and services for individuals with cognitive, developmental and intellectual disabilities in the Katy and West Houston area,” states Rhonda Johnstone, Executive Director of The Arc of Katy.

AERC maintains a Zero-Waste-to-Landfill Policy for all of its electronics and electrical recycling services. AERC maintains a strict policy on all data storage devices. All devices will either be wiped to the Department of Defense Standards or be physically destroyed. No information containing devices will leave any AERC facility. In addition to offering similar electronics recycling events throughout the country, all AERC facility locations host Drop-Off Fridays every Friday between the hours of 9AM and 3PM. AERC facilities in New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Florida, and California welcome local residents who wish to participate in the Drop-Off Friday program. Residents may drop off recyclable electronics and certain universal waste items during Drop-Off Fridays for a nominal fee.
